

Indiana Nurse License Compact FAQ

Current as of 8/20/20

Q: How do I know if I need an Indiana Nurse License Compact?

A: If your primary residence is in Indiana and you work as a nurse in Kentucky, you will need an Indiana Nurse License Compact.

Q: How is Primary State of Residence (PSOR) defined?

A: The PSOR is the state where applicant can prove legal residence to be proven by submitting one of the following: Driver's license with home address or Voter registration card with home address.

Q: I already have an Indiana Nurse License; do I need to get a compact license as well?

A: If you work as a nurse in Kentucky, yes. The compact license will be replacing the Kentucky license moving forward.

Q: I am an APRN, do I still need to get a compact license?

A: Yes. You will need to get the Indiana RN License Compact before Kentucky will issue you a renewal for your APRN License.

Q: I am a new grad that just got my Kentucky Nurse License prior to July 1st, 2020 and the expiration date shows 10/31/2021, do I still need an Indiana Nurse License Compact this year?

A: If you are a new Grad that obtained a KY license and your expiration date is for 10/31/2021, you may wait to convert to the IN compact nurse license. However, if your expiration is for 10/31/2020, you will have to convert before the expiration date. Any questions regarding this rule should be directed to the Kentucky Nursing Board.

Q: When do I need to have my Indiana Nurse License Compact?

A: You need to start the process now. If you cannot complete the Indiana compact process prior to October 31, 2020 you will be allowed to renew your KY license within the KY renewal period (Sept 15 – Oct 31) along with proof you have begun the IN

compact license process. You must have a valid KY or IN compact license by Oct 31 to meet licensure requirements

Q: Who do I need to submit my Indiana Nurse License Compact to?

A: You should turn them into your manager/leader and HR. Submissions to HR should be sent by email to Amanda Durham-Barnes at amanda.durham-barnes@uoflhealth.org.

Q: Indiana is saying that I will not complete the process for my Indiana Nurse License Compact by October 31st, 2020. How will that impact my position at UofL Health?

A: UofL Health must obey the laws and statutes set by the healthcare governing bodies. This means we must refer to the State Nursing Boards and the National Council of State Boards of Nursing. Kentucky Board of Nursing is providing extensions for these cases. Please contact the Kentucky Board of Nursing to make sure you qualify for this and for more information.
