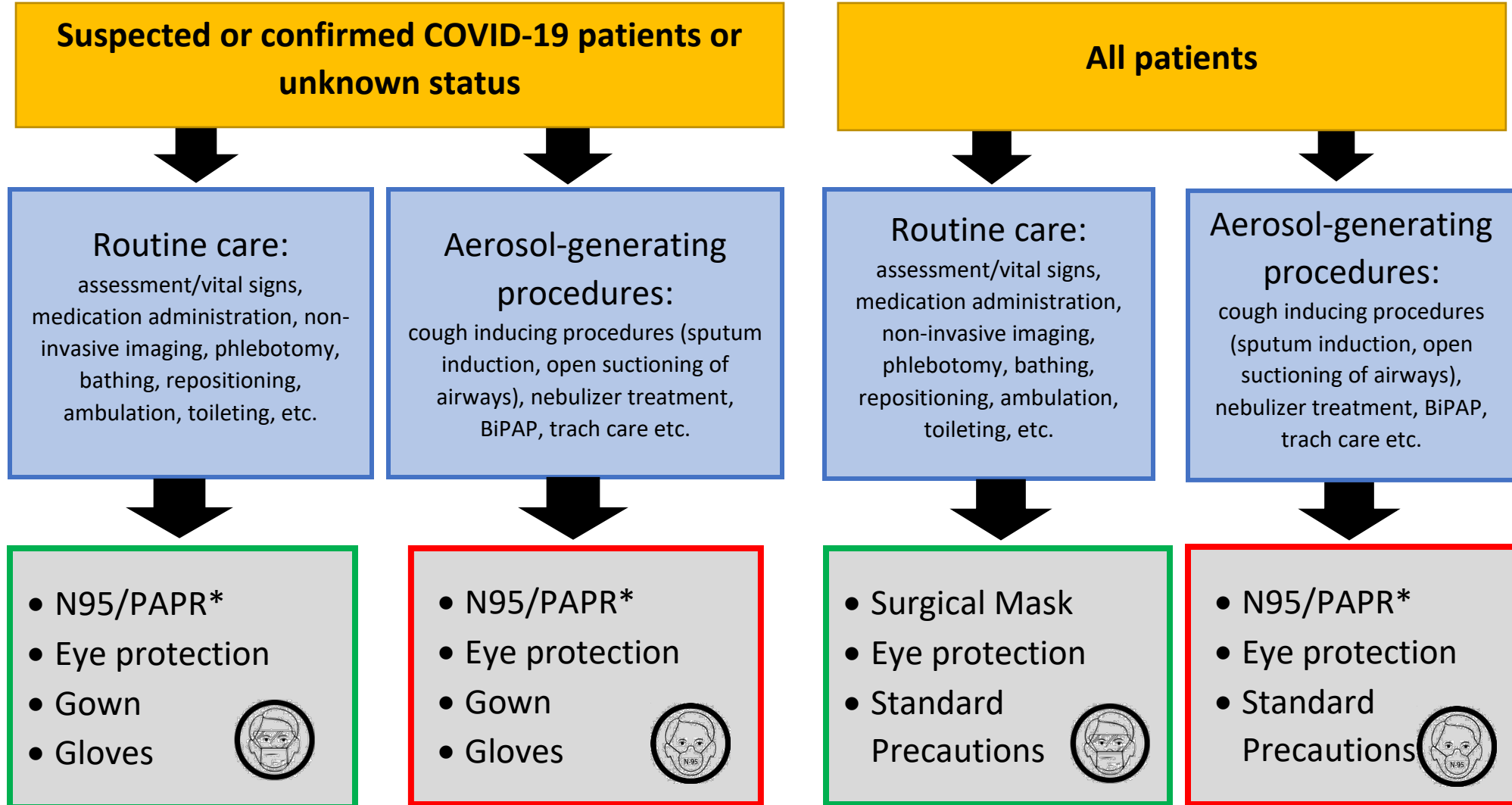


# COVID-19 PPE Requirements



## Aerosol-generating procedures as defined by the CDC:

Open suctioning of airways; sputum induction; cardiopulmonary resuscitation; endotracheal intubation and extubation; non-invasive ventilation (e.g., BiPAP, CPAP); bronchoscopy; manual ventilation; medical/surgical/ postmortem procedures using oscillating bone saws; and dental procedures involving: Ultrasonic scalers; high-speed dental handpieces; air/water syringes; air polishing; and air abrasion.

The CDC also lists high flow oxygen and nebulizer therapy as having the potential to create aerosolization, although the evidence is not strong.

**\*Utilize the style N95 respirator for which you have been fit tested. Individuals who have failed fit testing or have facial hair should utilize a PAPR as an alternative.**
